- **PYP Hats:** A hat <u>must</u> be worn by all PYP students during outdoor PE and at other times when out in the sun *e.g.* recess and lunch.
- **Shoes:** All students must wear enclosed shoes or running shoes.
- MYP Performing Arts Clothing For performing arts lessons students may wear a black lightweight T-shirt and long lightweight black leggings/ exercise trousers or black shorts.
 Students can go barefoot or wear non-slip socks. This clothing must be changed after class at the nearest possible break time.
- House t-shirts may be worn in lieu of white shirts on Friday's only.

Additional information for Secondary School students:

- In cooler times (or if necessary) students may wear a school sweatshirt
- Can wear plain hats/caps but only appropriately and in non-formal situations, not generally in the buildings or in lessons
- Jewellery: can generally wear appropriate items
- Hair: must have appropriate hairstyles

Make-up, nail length & nail polish:

MYP 1, 2 & 3 students may wear clear nail polish but generally no make-up.

MYP 4 & 5 students may wear clear nail polish & make-up that is subtle & appropriate for school.

DP1 & 2 students may wear coloured nail polish & make-up that is appropriate for school.

All students' nail lengths should not be too long, due to their involvement in practical subjects.

Please note that we do have non-uniform days throughout the school year.

On such days, students should still wear attire that is appropriate to the school setting, so that would include closed-toe shoes and would generally not involve a student wearing sleeve/short/skort/dress/skirt lengths less than he/she normally would when wearing his/her normal school uniform. Such a stance is to maintain protection against the same health & safety issues that could present themselves in the school day, but still respect that we are working in a Caribbean climate.
