### **MYP & DP Uniform Expectations**

#### **Purpose**

The school uniform promotes a sense of belonging, supports a positive learning environment, and reinforces the principles of respect, responsibility, and professionalism.

Students are expected to wear the prescribed uniform correctly and maintain a neat, clean, and appropriate appearance at all times. The Head of School reserves the right to make final decisions regarding the suitability of attire and appearance.

#### **Daily Uniform**

##### **MYP 1–5**

##### **Students must wear:**

- Navy blue school shorts or
- Navy blue school skirt/skort (minimum knee length)
- White school shirt with school crest
- White socks
- Enclosed black shoes or athletic shoes

##### **DP 1–2**

##### **Students must wear:**

- Navy blue school shorts or
- Navy blue school skirt/skort (minimum knee length)
- White school polo shirt with school crest
- White socks
- Enclosed black shoes or athletic shoes

**Important:** Skirts and skorts must be at least knee length. This expectation will be strictly enforced.

#### **Physical Education Uniform**

For all MYP and DP students:

- Navy gym shorts
  - House T-shirt
  - Appropriate athletic footwear
- 

### **Performing Arts Attire (MYP 1–4)**

Students enrolled in Performing Arts are required to have:

- Plain black T-shirt
- Plain black shorts, black leggings, or black athletic trousers

Students should change into their Performing Arts attire for practical lessons and return to their regular school uniform at the next available break.

### **Additional Uniform Information**

#### **Fridays**

House T-shirts may be worn in place of the regular school shirt on Fridays only.

#### **Outerwear**

Students may wear the approved school sweatshirt during cooler weather or in air-conditioned learning spaces.

#### **Footwear**

All students must wear enclosed shoes suitable for a school environment.

#### **Hats and Caps**

Plain hats or caps may be worn outdoors for sun protection. They should not be worn inside buildings, classrooms, assemblies, or other formal school occasions unless permission has been granted.

#### **Jewellery**

Students may wear appropriate jewellery that does not present a safety concern or disrupt the learning environment.

### **Hair**

Hairstyles should be neat, safe, and appropriate for a school setting.

### **Make-up and Nails**

#### **MYP 1–3**

- Clear nail polish only
- No make-up

#### **MYP 4–5**

- Clear nail polish permitted
- Subtle and age-appropriate make-up permitted

#### **DP 1–2**

- Coloured nail polish permitted
- Make-up may be worn provided it remains appropriate for a school setting

For all students, nail length must be practical and safe for participation in lessons, laboratories, performing arts, design, and physical education activities.

---

### **Non-Uniform Days**

Students may occasionally participate in approved non-uniform days. Clothing must remain appropriate for an educational environment and should reflect the school's expectations regarding safety, respect, and professionalism.

Students are expected to wear:

- Enclosed footwear
  - Clothing that provides appropriate coverage
  - Attire suitable for active participation in the school day

### **Purchasing Uniforms**

All uniform items are available for purchase through the school's uniform supplier, with the exception of the Performing Arts black shorts, leggings, or athletic trousers, which families may purchase independently.
